



ATM Safety Tips

- Conduct transactions during the day.
- Beware of shoulder surfing (someone attempting to view your transaction).
- Always protect your PIN#.
- Don't re-enter your PIN if the ATM eats your card.
- Call us right away if your card is held by the machine.
- Use well-lighted locations.
- Know where the security cameras are located.
- Never count cash until you are at a safe location.
- Be wary if anyone offers to “help” with your ATM transactions.
- Be suspicious if signage states to use a specific machine or if the ATM looks unusual.
- Pay close attention to the ATM and your surroundings.
- If you feel uncomfortable, use another machine.
- Alert us immediately to any suspicious activity around the machine.
- Be on the lookout for fraudulent withdrawals on your statement.
